Australia and the European Union have strong and long established familial and cultural ties. The European Union is also one of Australia's major trading partners, whilst Europe plays a significant role in international relations. So the relationship between the European Union and Australia is an important one. The EU Ambassador to Australia, Ambassador Daly is well qualified to speak on European Union / Australia relations.

Biography

Ambassador Daly has had a distinguished career in the diplomatic service of the Republic of Ireland and then the European Union. He has extensive experience with the accession of new states to the Union and in particular experience in dealing with those of the Balkans. He was the Head of the Commission's unit negotiating the accession of Croatia to the Union. He has also served in many other placements dealing with the Central and Eastern European countries during the 1990s as they transformed their political and economic systems and moved toward joining the European Union. He has been the head of the EU Commission's Delegation to Australia since January 2009.
